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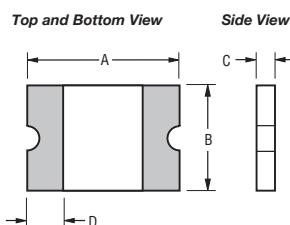

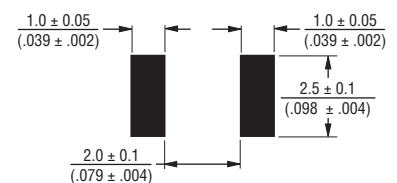

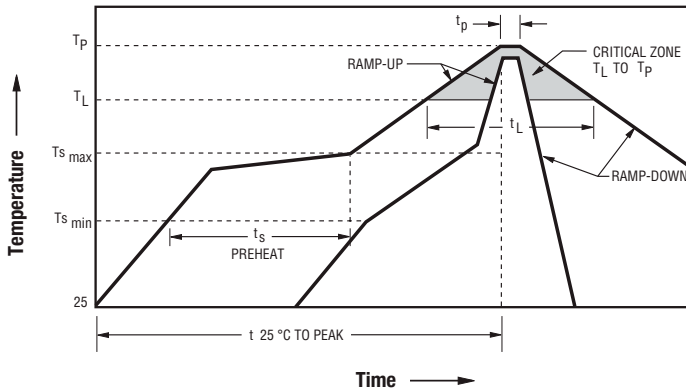

- MF-USMF models are intended for reflow soldering (including, but not limited to heating plate, hot air, IR, nitrogen, and vapor phase).
- Wave soldering is permissible only if the device is on the top of the PCB, opposite the heat source.
- Hand soldering is not recommended for these devices.

- If reflow temperatures exceed the recommended profile, devices may not meet the published specifications.

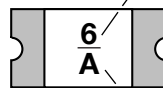

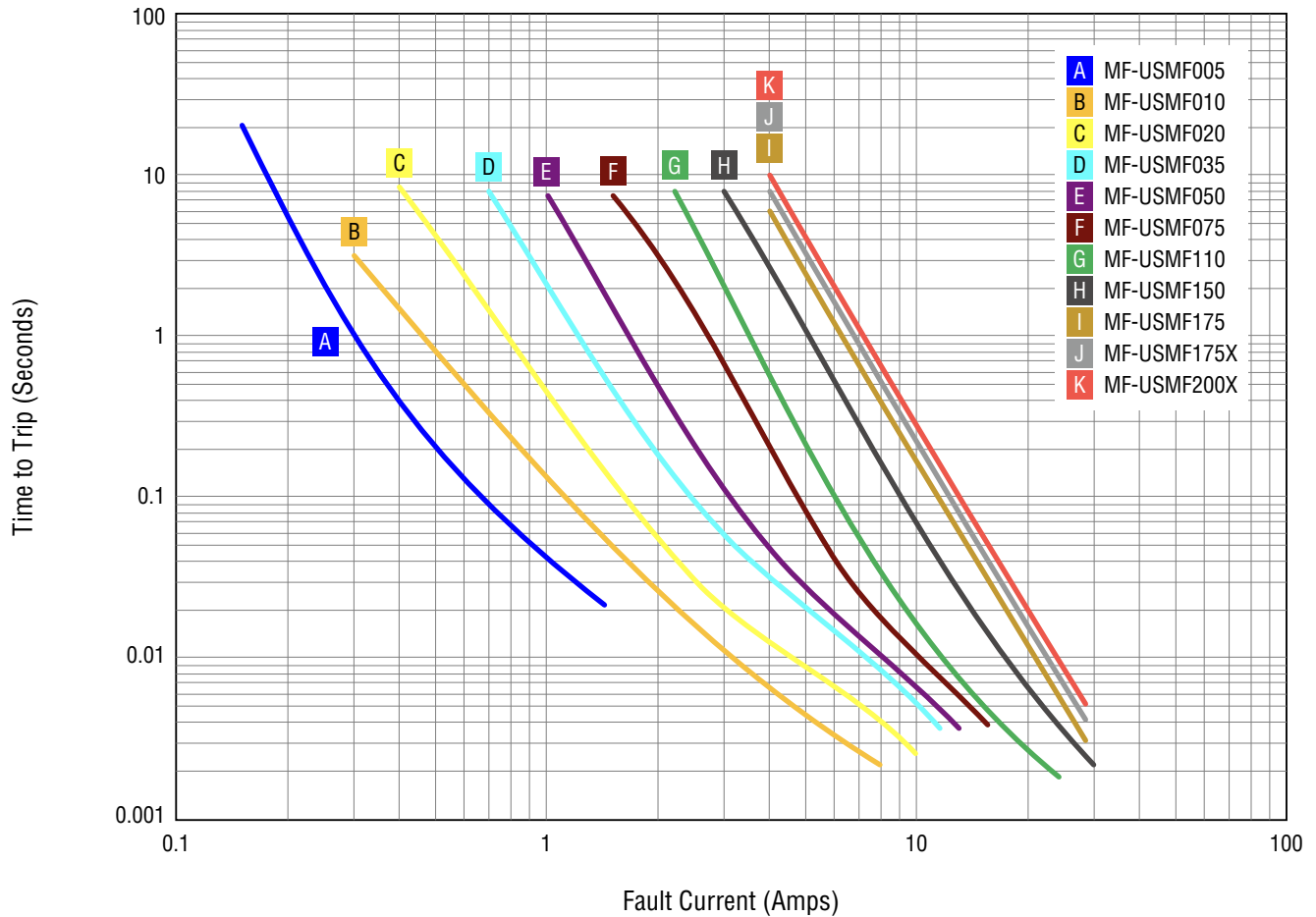

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Typical Time to Trip at 23 °C



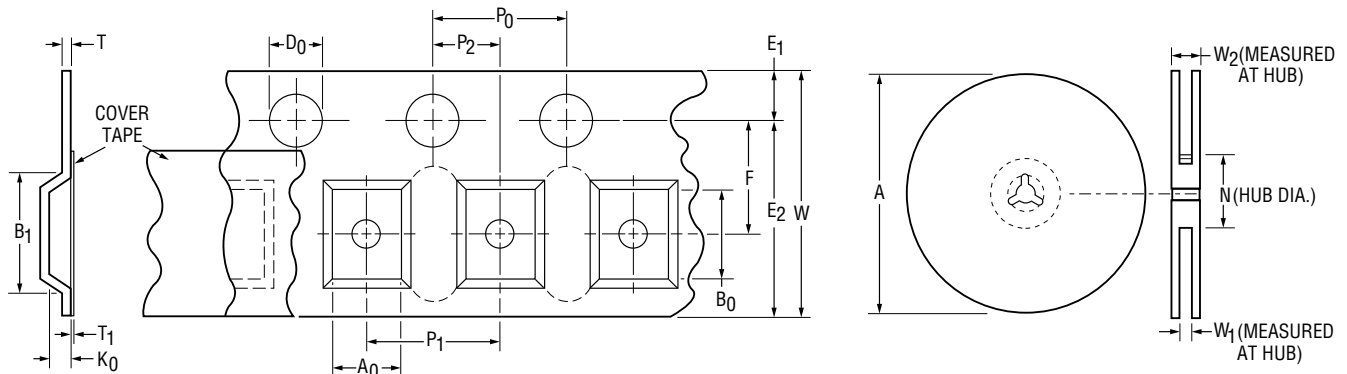

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Application Notice
