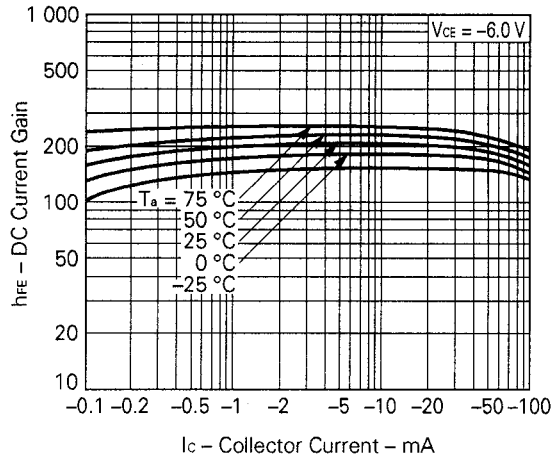

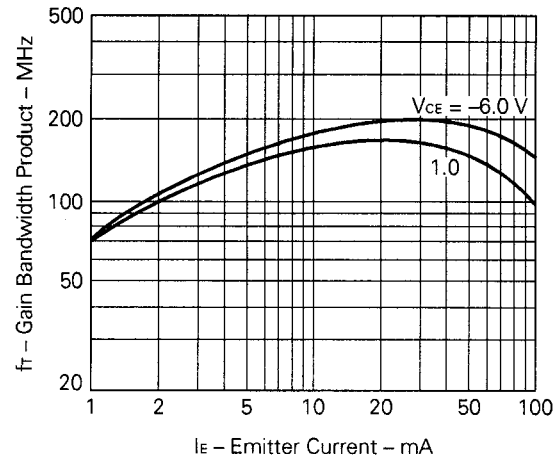
TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS ($T_a = 25^\circ\text{C}$)



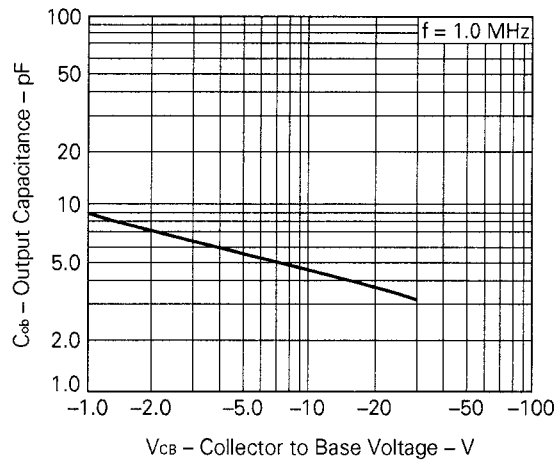
DC CURRENT GAIN vs.
COLLECTOR CURRENT



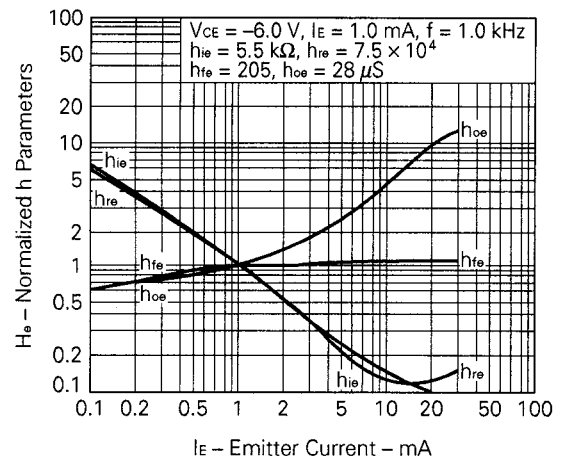
GAIN BANDWIDTH PRODUCT vs.
EMITTER CURRENT



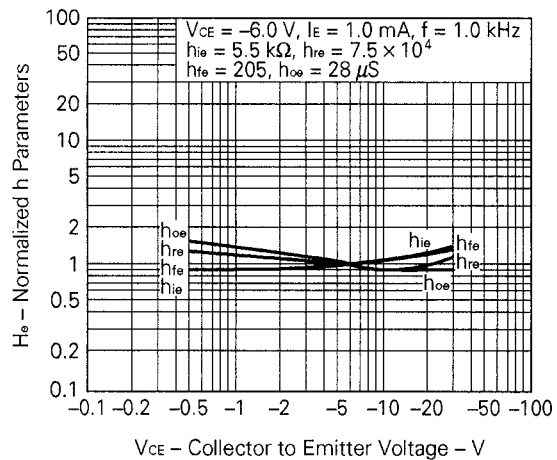
OUTPUT CAPACITANCE vs.
