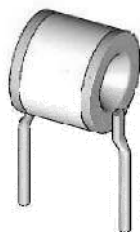
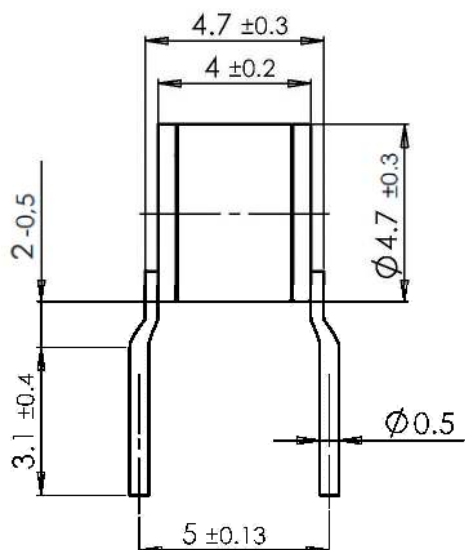

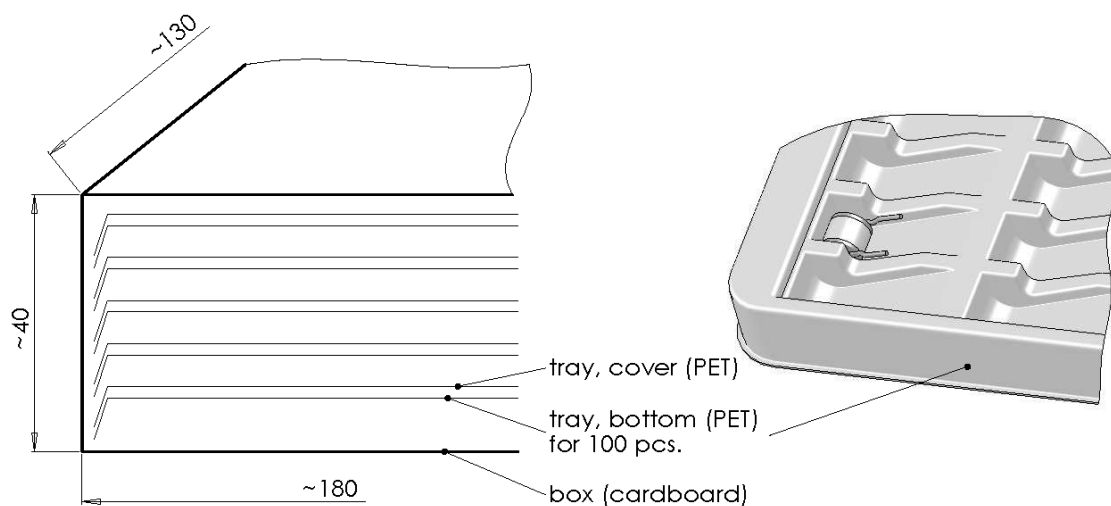
Dimensional drawing in mm

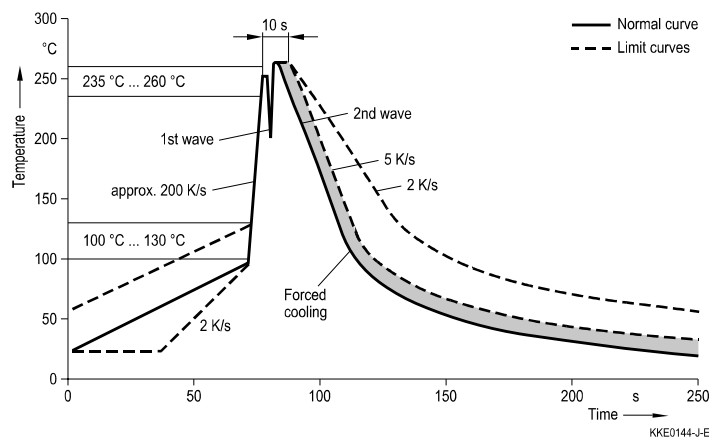

Cautions and warnings

- Do not operate surge arresters in power supply networks, whose maximum operating voltage exceeds the minimum spark-over voltage of the surge arresters.
