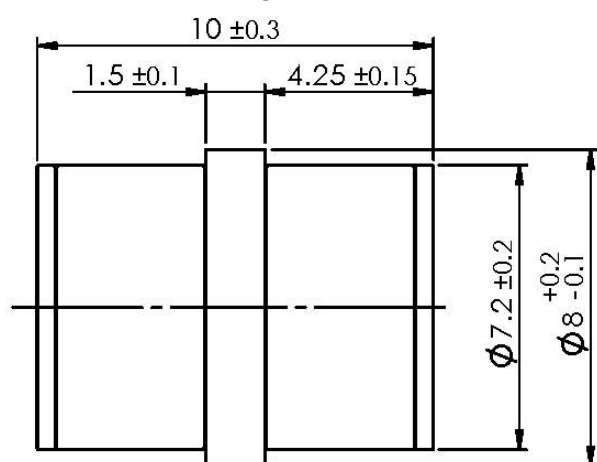

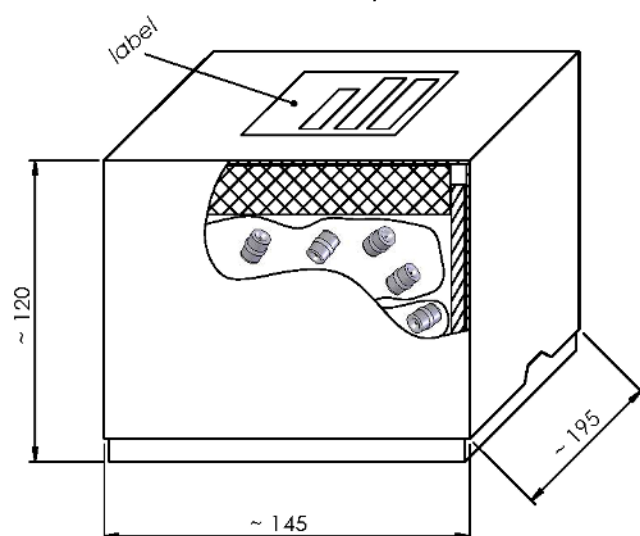
Dimensional drawing in mm



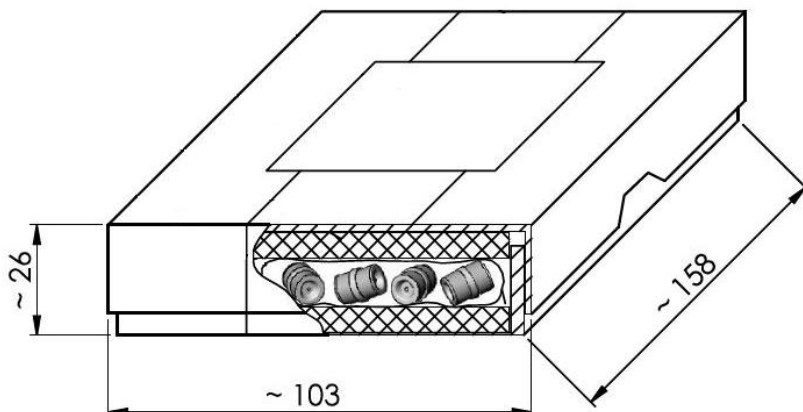
